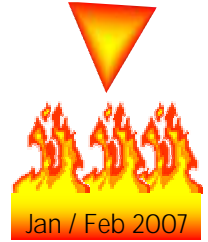

The diner is an original and began life in 1952 as 'Murphy's Diner' in Cambridge, Massachusetts. Somehow it found it's way over to England & was eventually abandoned as a project & put up for sale on Ebay. When they found it, Jeff & Tricia, it's now proud owners, knew it was the change in direction they were after! But what do you do when you are the successful bidders on a 42 ton, 55ft long steel diner which is 24 miles away from where

you want it to be?! That's the challenge the couple faced, that & it's restoration back to the glory of the 50's. They've done a smashing job & agree



that the 10 hour journey to get it to the site & then the 10 long months of refurbishment were well worth it. The 35 seater diner is themed with music from the vintage jukebox and the menu is served by friendly waitresses in retro outfits! It's an ideal opportunity to take a

step back in time and with a section on the menu called **The Wild Bunch** we should all fit in very well! Don't worry, their 'Wild Bunch' refers to the succulent 8oz steak options but if they don't take your fancy there's the 'Hall of Fame' Hamburger range or the 'Hot Diggity Dogs', it's a real treat & fabulously imaginative!! I dare you not to get carried away with the atmosphere! The diner is open Tuesday to Sunday, mainly evenings, and it's best to book in advance as it does get very busy especially in the summer.
